### *Lived Experience Leader (Designated role)*

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#### About the Awards

The Mental Health Coalition of SA (MHCSA) is committed to building a high quality skilled, qualified, valued and thriving Lived Experience workforce in the SA non-Government (NGO) mental health sector. As a program of the MHCSA, the Lived Experience Workforce Program (LEWP) leads this workforce development and is proud to present these Awards. We are honoured to recognise and celebrate the outstanding achievements of people in paid, designated mental health Lived Experience roles in SA and people who are currently undertaking Peer Work study with SA-based Registered Training Organisations.

#### SELECTION CRITERIA

##### Category 2: Lived Experience Leader (Designated role) - One Award

#### Selection Criteria

An individual in a paid role in the NGO or Government mental health sector, which is a designated Lived Experience role (personal Lived Experience of mental health challenges and periods of healing/recovery or of supporting someone (carer/family) is named as an essential criterion).

The position requires the application of Lived Experience in ways other than direct recovery work as defined in Category 1. For example Lived Experience management, leadership, peer supervision, project work, advocacy, promotion, policy work, education and training (that is not focussed on recovery support) etc.

The person must be nominated or self-nominate in one category only.

Nominations must include:

1. Evidence taken from the person's Job Description verifying that they are practicing in a paid, designated Lived Experience leadership position
2. Examples of how the Nominee embodies the noted Core Principle of Lived Experience work in their role (up to 400 words)
3. One example of work the person has produced or contributed to, that supports the progression of Lived Experience in SA e.g. committee representation, workforce development, conference presentation, publication, governance, research, policy development, systemic advocacy etc.
4. Details of one referee who can be contacted to verify the above evidence

#### How to Nominate

Nominations are open from July 4<sup>th</sup>, close on 30<sup>th</sup> August and should be emailed to [administration@mhcsa.org.au](mailto:administration@mhcsa.org.au) Received forms will be acknowledged by email – **if you do not receive confirmation within 48 hours of submission, it is your responsibility to follow up with the MHCSA.** Office hours are Monday-Thursday 9am-5pm: Nominations received

outside these hours will be acknowledged during office hours. Late submissions, or forms that have not been received by the MHCSA and are not followed up, will not be considered.

## Judging

To be considered eligible, an entry must meet and address all relevant category criteria noted above. Nominations will be treated confidentially and used solely for the purposes of judging and awarding prizes. Judging will take place between September 1<sup>st</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> by a panel consisting of Lived Experience workforce expertise. The panel will select up to three Finalists in each category. Decisions are final, no correspondence will be entered into.

All finalists will be announced publicly by the MHCSA and invited to receive their prizes at the Awards Dinner in late October (date and location to be confirmed), at which time the overall winner in each category will be announced and presented with their Award. Finalists and winners will be photographed and may be asked to speak with the media and/or other organisations.
